The Mute Swan in Ayrshire

During the Spring of 1955 a census was made of the mute swan (cygnus olor) population in Britain. The results were published in Bird Study, the journal of the British Trust for Ornithology; those for Scotland in Vol. 5, p. 45, and those for England and Wales in Vol. 7, p. 208.

My contribution was a count, as complete as I could manage in the time at my disposal, of the swans in our county and their nests and cygnets. Owing to the mobility of the birds and the length of time necessarily spent on the search, totals can only be approximate. In addition, birds which are too young to breed, and birds which have failed in their efforts to nest, congregate in suitable places in herds, which increase in size as the season advances.

The swans are fairly evenly distributed over the county's waters, which provide suitable food, and are generally below the 700 ft. contour line. There were counted 33 nests, 114 cygnets and 206 adult swans, as shown in the map and tables.




Fig. 4.—Status of Mute Swan (Cygnus olor) in Ayrshire—Spring 1955.
