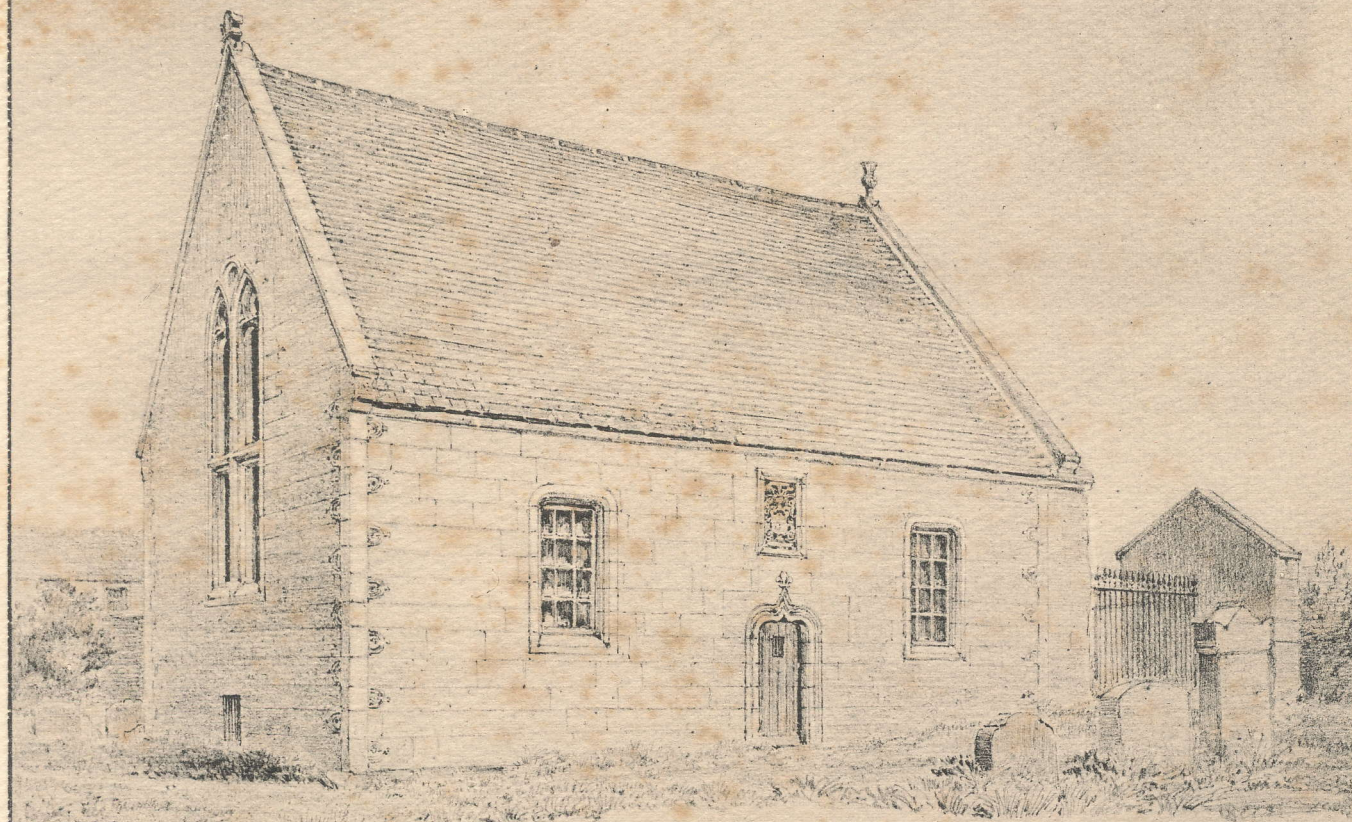


Fig. 1. The "Aisle" from the north-west.

Fig. 2. Panel and top of Doorway.

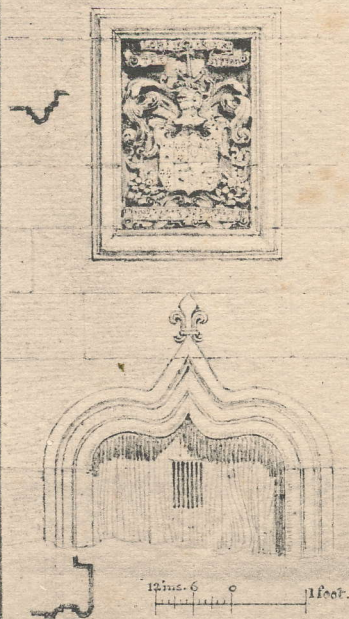
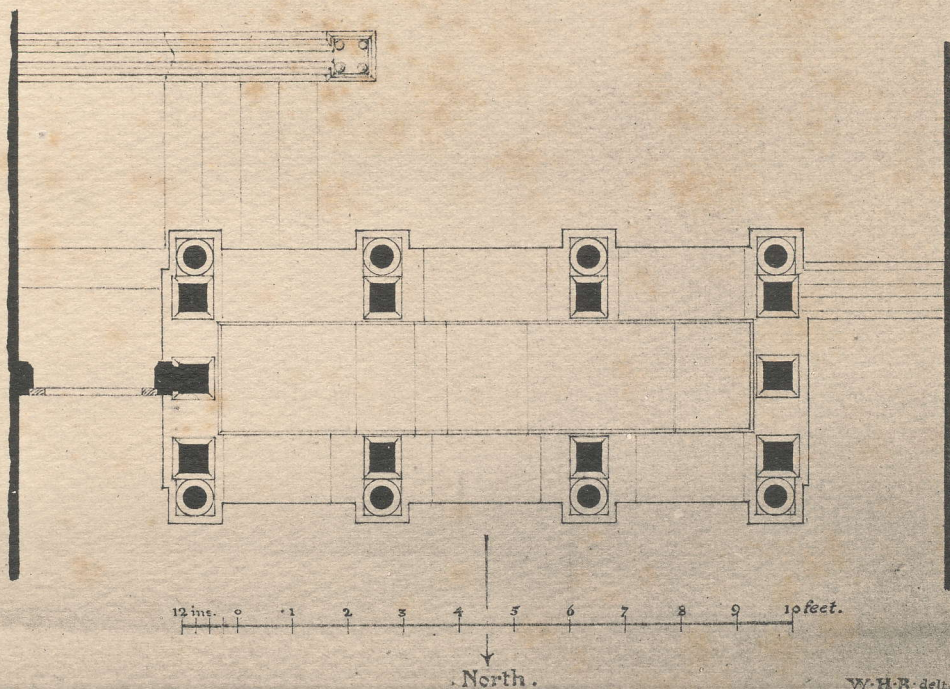


Fig. 3. Plan of the Monument.

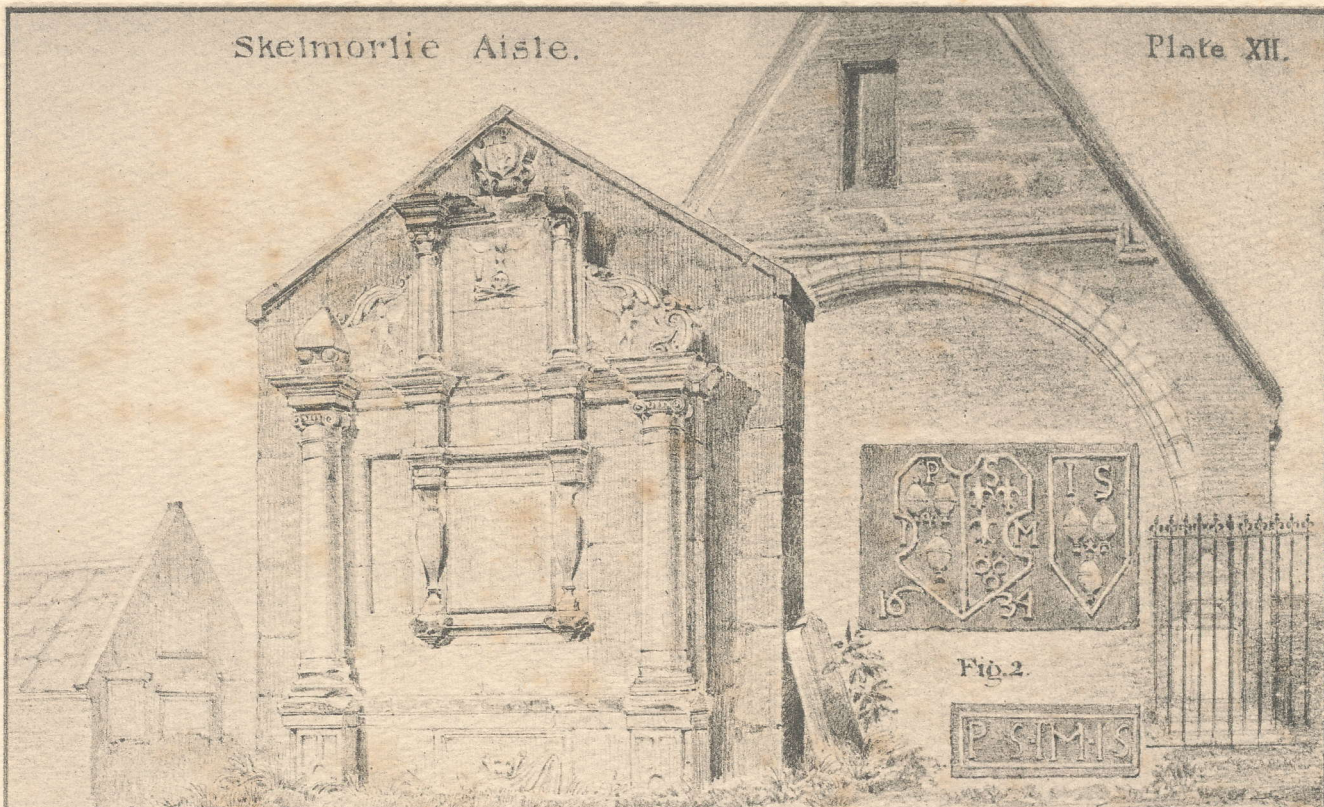

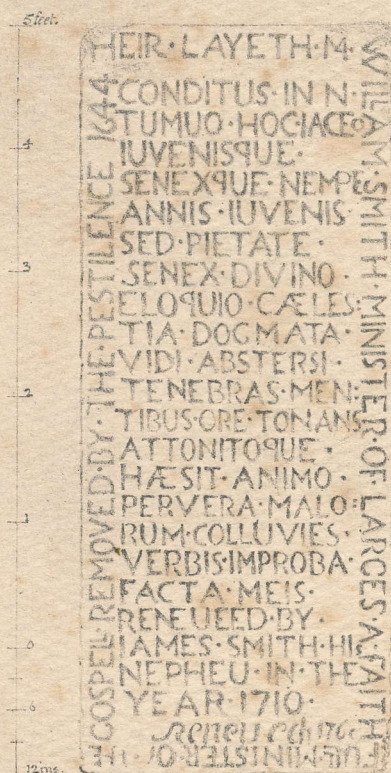


Fig. 3. Ministers' Komb.

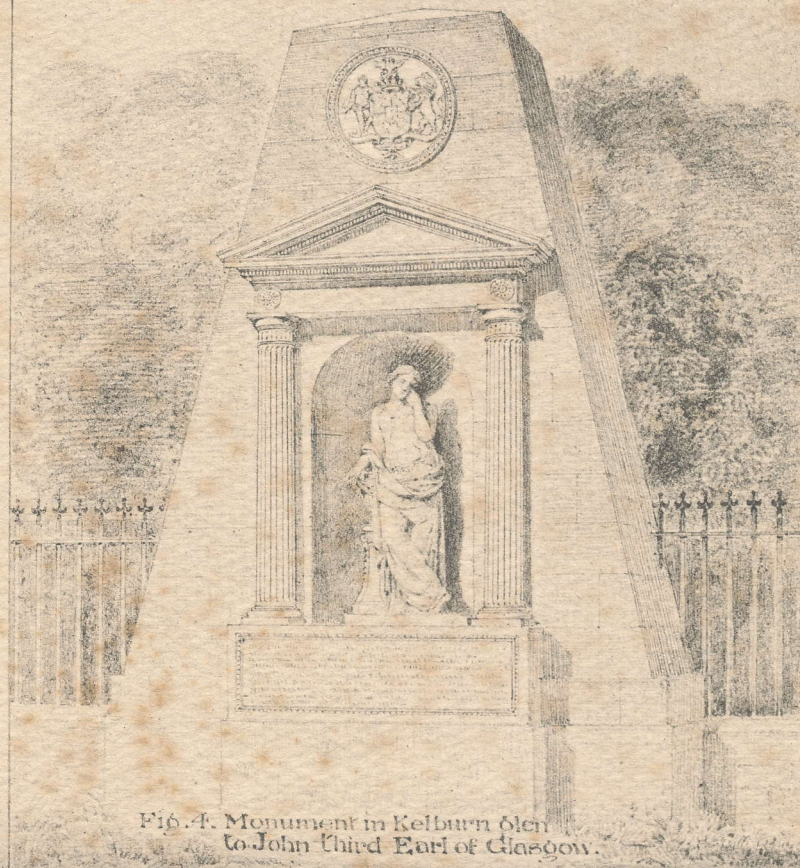


Fig. 4. Monument in Kelburn Glen
