
BLAZON-

Or, a fess chequy, argent and azure, surmounted of a bend engrailed, gules, within a double tressure flory-counterflory, of the last.

Crest—A Pelican in her piety, proper.

Supporters—Dexter, a savage, wreathed about the head and loins with laurel, holding a club over his dexter shoulder, all proper: Sinister—A lion gules, armed and langued azure.

Motto — "Virescit bulnere birtus."
